- ❖ 14 people were in attendance.
- ❖ Fred Suplee called meeting to order at 7:07 p.m.
- ❖ **President's report:** Fred announced that we got a grant opportunity from Kent Lambert at Provident Bank. We may get a small donation in June. He also said that Mrs. Hendrickson will be having her spring concert on 5/26/11 at Central M.S. at 6:00 for elementary and at 7:00 pm for Middle School. The boosters suggested buying a set amount of \$2,000.00 to start off and having a block of merchandise ready to sell at the banquet and at the spring concert. Motion was made to make an initial purchase of \$2,000.00 of Scrip. Paul Richardson motioned to approve the initial purchase of Scrip and seconded by Phil Pitchford. Also, a monthly inventory will be kept up to date of what goes out. Motion was made by Jon Largent to have the Treasurer take physical inventory of merchandise and give a report as part of the treasurer's report at every meeting, seconded by Veronica Epperson. Motion passed. Paul Richardson suggested we buy a banner that says "Riverside Poly Band Scrip Sold Here". The banner will cost about \$50.00. Veronica motioned to approve the purchase of the banner and Dawn Mayhew seconded the motion.
- ❖ Veronica Epperson and Dawn Mayhew volunteered to talk to parents at Central M.S. during their May 12th performance and perhaps set up a table.
- ❖ Minutes were read. Motion to approve minutes was made by Phil Pitchford and seconded by Kim Lane
- ❖ **Treasurer's report:** As of 4/30/11, we are \$9,600.00 in the red. Soon we will be in the black since we will be having the silent auction soon and tickets will be sold for the spring banquet plus the revenues from Ralphs and Vons Scrip. Veronica made motion to approve the treasurer's report and Paul seconded the motion.

- ❖ **2nd VP Report (Paul and Joe): Paul:** Goodwill fundraiser made \$3,550.00. We will be having another one in August the Saturday after band camp. - ❖ No date has been set yet to meet with Mr. Coe and cheer and football boosters to discuss sharing sales at football games. Fred will make another attempt to have this combined effort occur.
- ❖ **Elections:** We have very few nominations for board positions next year. No one has nominated someone for Ways and Means. Initiatives will be in the ballot to have more than one person for each position.
- ❖ Motion to adjourn meeting was made by Paul Richardson and seconded by Veronica Epperson.
